

WHAT YOUR CHILD WILL NEED FOR HIS OR HER FIRST VISIT

- Owl (please see templates) with his/her name on the back
- His/her picture (1 ½" X 1 ¼")

Before your child comes to his her first reading, please help him or her make an owl. You can use either the B/W or color template. If you are using the B/W template, please have your child color them in. All children will create their own attendance logs during their initial session by gluing owls on log booklets. Each child will keep a record of his or her attendance at the reading club. The logs will not be sent home. Instead, they will be kept on file for your child's next visit.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWL

Directions:

Cut out the template pieces (young children may need help with this step)

Glue the owl together:

- Glue small oval onto the larger oval so the bottoms line up
- Glue the large triangle onto the large oval so the tops line up
- Glue the small triangle (beak) and eyes onto the owl
- Glue the centers of the eyes on
- Glue the two medium sized circles onto the bottom as feet
